INJAZZ

InJazz, an initiative of Buma, is the biggest jazz network and showcase event in the Netherlands. It brings together the national and international jazz sector in a dynamic setting: a paid professionals' program aimed at connection happens next to a showcase festival offering a variety of Dutch bands, free of charge and open to the general public. In 2022, inJazz took place over three days in both Amsterdam and Rotterdam.

InJazz is attended by professionals such as composers, musicians, representatives of national and international clubs, venues and festivals, as well as booking agen-

cies, record labels, management companies, media and delegations from abroad.

Every year during inJazz the winner of the prestigious Boy Edgar Prize is announced. This is the most important Dutch prize for jazz and improvised music. Recent winners are Tineke Postma (2015), Wilbert de Joode (2016), Martin Fondse (2017), Jasper van 't Hof (2018), Jasper Blom (2019), Ack van Rooyen (2020) and Ronald Snijders (2022).

Every year, the NN North Sea Jazz Festival grants a free composition assignment to a promising Dutch jazz composer. This year the honor goes to saxophonist, arranger and composer Marike van Dijk. Marike van Dijk (1982) studied at conservatories in both Rotterdam and Amsterdam and after that left for New York. There, she was educated at the renowned Manhattan School of Music and granted a scholarship to New York University, where she studied with pianist and arranger Gil Goldstein. About his former pupil and her latest album, 2018's *The Stereography Project*, Goldstein said: "Marike's writing has an organic quality; balanced and seeming to find ratios and combinations that are based in nature. I find her music very intuitive and feel that she has great honesty. This record will be just another step in a long career of composing." In her youth, Van Dijk played in several big bands and orchestra's, which resulted in the founding of her own big ensemble, *The Stereography Project*. In addition to this, she performs with a range of smaller groups and works on several interdisciplinary projects.

Alto saxophonist Mo van der Does (1997) won the Conservatorium Talent Award, the Prinses Christina Concours and the Keep an Eye: The Records competition. The latter award allowed him to record *Motet*, his second album, following his debut *Common Myths*. The album arose from a composition commissioned by the Bimhuis in Amsterdam in 2020. On it, van der Does presents eight new pieces with the self-titled group, consisting of trumpeter Alistair Payne, tenor saxophonist/flutist Matthias van den Brande, bass clarinetist Jessie Brevé, pianist Floris Kappeyne, bassist Tijs Klaassen and drummer Wouter Kühne. (Suzan Veneman will replace Alistair Payne during the North Sea Jazz performance.) They perform with the force of a big band and the flexibility of a small ensemble while exploring a world of composition, orchestration and improvisation. Their music is filled with hefty grooves, lyrical and melancholy melodies, and orchestral explosions. There is also a suite: *Motet I, II and III*, and a track with the curious title *Edward & Charles At The Diner*.

Sudanese-Dutch singer-songwriter Gidaa has demonstrated to be one of the most interesting neo-soul talents of recent years. Producer Full Crate was impressed when he heard her singing for the first time in 2018. That same year they made *A Storm On A Summers Day*, which led to Gidaa's breakthrough. Since that time, the song has been streamed on Spotify over 12 million times. One year later, YouTube platform COLORS invited her to record her single *Morning Blue* as part of a larger project drawing attention to the socio-political climate in Sudan. In 2020, Gidaa received glowing reviews at Eurosonic Noorderslag and for her EP *Overture*. Its eight songs are characterized by a refined soul sound, with acoustic playing and astounding singing. Gidaa sings sincere and meaningful lyrics in which she bares her soul.

South-Korean Sun-Mi Hong started drumming when she was 17. Following her studies at the prestigious Howon University in Gunsan, she went to the Amsterdam Conservatory, where she followed one of Europe's most respected jazz programs. Sun-Mi was influenced by the music of Brian Blade, Ari Hoenig and Roy Haynes, among others. In 2017 she recorded her self-released debut album *First Page*. One year later she won the Dutch Jazz Competition with her quintet. According to the jury report "the group is the most organic in an emotional, playful and spiritual way and with the right attitude." In the summer of 2020, she released her wonderful second album *Second Page: A Self-Strewn Portrait*, for which she received an Edison Award. The Sun-Mi Hong Quintet will grab you with compositions that are filled with catchy melodies and dramatic explosive parts, alongside mysterious impressionistic patterns of sounds and irregular tempos.

That he claims to have been born from a coconut may not be the craziest thing about Gino-Cochise. His completely unique sound is even more astonishing and fascinating. He's all about meditation through sound and healing through movement. The spirituality behind his music manifests itself in experimental electronics, hip hop, soul and a host of indefinable styles. His staccato whispering rap voice is recognized by thousands. But don't think it's all madness: Gino-Cochise has already given impressive performances at Glastonbury, Eurosonic Noorderslag, and NN North Sea Jazz Downtown. His album *LBM III* is a book of sounds that listeners will never finish reading. Dreamlike and compelling at the same time, Gino-Cochise's music takes us into his own anti-materialistic universe where everyone is allowed to live in freedom and good health.

It's difficult to label the music of jazz composer Tijn Wybenga. Violins, saxophones, drums, samplers, electronics - everything is possible in his world. With his band AM.OK (Amsterdam Modern Orkest) Wybenga started a new musical group that demonstrates the diversity of the young Dutch music scene. The widely acclaimed debut album *Brinteaser* was released in July 2021. On it are five pieces that Wybenga and his fourteen-member orchestra recorded in the influential Amsterdam jazz venue Bimhuis. On the album, he worked with improvising musicians like Reinier Baas, Ben van Gelder and Joris Roelofs. Wybenga re-used small, improvised pieces as the basis for new grooves, beats and sound patterns. At NN North Sea Jazz, Tijn Wybenga & AM.OK will perform, for the first time, the music for the composition competition of the November Music festival.

The group SMANDEM. consists of Aäron Bouwman (bass), David Nino van der Grinten (keyboards), Rafael Devante Sinay (guitar) and Kick Woudstra (drums). They are all young musicians who met at the Amsterdam Conservatory. Although guitarist Sinay and pianist van der Grinten take the initiative when it comes to composing, Bouwman and Woudstra have major supplementary roles. Their debut EP from 2021 is called *Self-Titled* and, strangely enough, it was released as a 13-inch vinyl LP. The group is inspired by leading examples like Herbie Hancock, Christian Scott, and Wayne Shorter, but also by younger pop artists like Travis Scott and Drake. Although their feeling for jazz is undeniable, the sound of the foursome is not related to any country or genre. The quartet considers tradition to be a living thing, with an obligation to develop, explore and adapt.

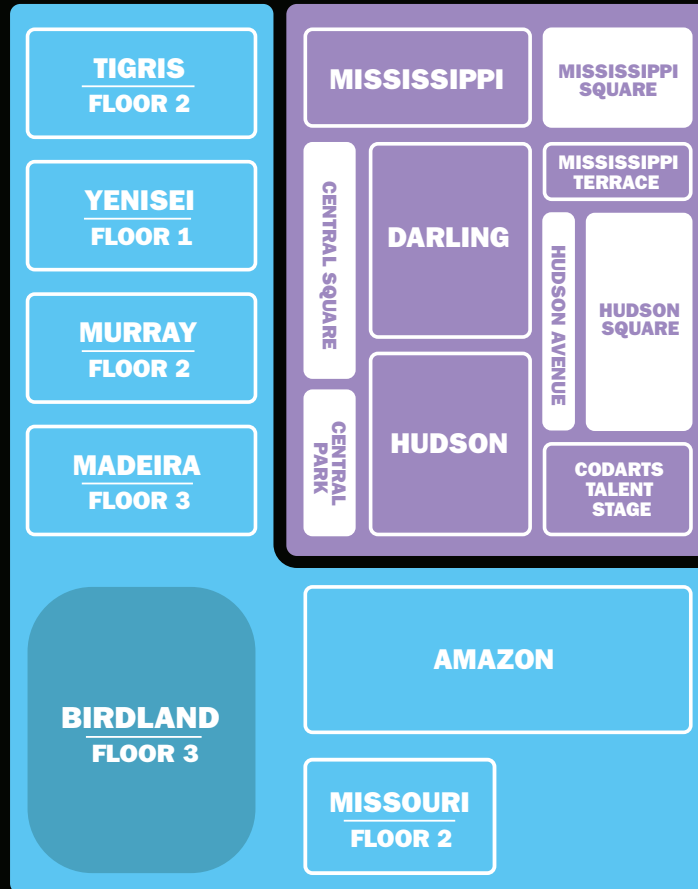
